Project Highlights

Maine Turnpike is making improvements to the New County Road (Route 5) underpass in 2025

- This bridge is part of a contract for repairs to three bridges
- In total it is a \$700,000 contract
- Repairs to the New County Rd Bridge will cost approximately \$411,000
- Awarded to CPM Constructors, Inc., of Freeport, Maine
- Work is expected to start in late summer

The work consists of:

- New pavement on the bridge's surface
- Repairing bridge joints (this will help reduce the chance of plow damage to the joints)
- Installing elastomeric concrete headers to provide strength and protection to the bridge joints

This project consists of bridge and approach mill and overlay paving, bridge joint repairs, header installation, girder haunch removal and other repairs.

The work is anticipated to begin in mid-summer. There will be one lane of traffic on the bridge while work is in progress. Traffic will be controlled by a temporary traffic signal. The majority of the work will be complete by the end of August.

All work is scheduled to be complete by the end of 2025.
