Project Highlights

Maine Turnpike is making improvements to the Middle Road (Route 9) underpass in 2025

- This bridge is part of a contract for repairs to three bridges
- In total it is a \$700,000 contract
- Repairs to Middle Rd Bridge will be approximately \$175,000
- Awarded to CPM Constructors, Inc., of Freeport, Maine
- Work is expected to start in late summer and take two weeks

The work consists of:

- Repairing bridge joints (this will help reduce the chance of plow damage to the joints)
- New header installation
- Superstructure repairs

On the Middle Road Bridge, the work consists of bridge joint repairs, header installation, and miscellaneous superstructure repairs.

The majority of this work will take place at night with single lane closures and alternating one way traffic.

Work is anticipated to start in the late summer and last approximately 2 weeks. All work is scheduled to be complete by the end of 2025.
