Question 1: Is rapid deployment the only method that will be accepted for work over the traffic lanes? Will MTA allow containing to the ground as an alternative?

Answer: As per the drawing sheets in Appendix B, rapid deployment containment is required over all paved surfaces (travel lanes and shoulders). No alternative containment methods over paved surfaces will be considered. Bridge to ground tarps for containment enclosures are not permitted.





Site 1: Shaker Rd Underpass Bridge (Gray)





Site 2: Weymouth Rd Underpass Bridge (Gray)



10 - PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

506.11 Waste Management requirements (SP - 32)

- On-site waste storage allowed at Weymouth Rd and Bennett Rd
 - Refer to Contractor's Staging Plans in Appendix D for designated locations
- No on-site waste storage allowed at Shaker Rd
 - Storage shall be at Gray maintenance facility (1 mile south at Exit 63)
- Contractor shall obtain temporary provisional generator status from MaineDEP per work location.





13 - PROSECUTION OF WORK

- All cleaning and painting over paved surfaces shall be done from a Rapid Deployment Unit.
- Containment: Attach to main framing members only.
 No tapping or drilling into the existing bridge concrete will be allowed.
- No deck space will be provided on the Shaker Road Underpass bridge in Gray.

<u>Appendix B - Permitted Lane Closure Notes - Turnpike</u>


- > Turnpike lane closures are permitted EXCEPT
 - NB **no lane closures** 3-7 PM Mon-Fri (July and August)
 - SB **no lane closures** 11 AM 5 PM Sunday (July and August)
- ➤ Turnpike lane closures are permitted <u>only when</u> <u>work is underway</u>
- > TMAs, Automated Trailer-Mounted Speed Limit Signs, PCMS REQUIRED





<u>Appendix D - Temporary Traffic Signals (Weymouth, Bennett)</u>

- Submit TCP to MTA for approval
- Use PCMS for 2-week notice of lane closure







General Notes

- Submit TCP for each bridge site to MTA for approval
 - 2-week notice of start of MOT
- Short-term lane closures on underpass bridges allowed
 - Shaker Rd Underpass Bridge: No lane closures 7-9 AM or 3-5 PM
- Emergency Vehicle Ramps must remain open at all times
- No turning in private roads or driveways





15 - MOBILIZATION

• **Item 659.10** covers all contractor equipment, access, and storage for all work locations.





19 - SPECIFIC CONTRACT ITEMS

- Item 506 Coatings: individual pay items are provided for painting, surface prep, containment system, and waste disposal for each of the three bridge sites
- Item 652 Maintenance of Traffic: individual lump-sum pay item is provided for each bridge site
 - Includes all items for MOT above and below underpass bridge
 - Temporary signals, TMAs, PCMS, flaggers, signs, etc.
