March 11, 2024


1. Pursuant to notice, a special meeting of the Maine Turnpike Authority was held at 4 p.m. on March 11, 2024.

The meeting consisted of discussion with staff on the advisability of purchasing the majority of the Hebert property in Gorham, Maine, as opposed to the corridor needed for the Gorham Connector itself, and its property's potential use for wetland mitigation and/or a trail system. The consensus of those board members present was that the property should be purchased if it could be obtained at a reasonable price, and a purchase and sale entered into if possible, subject to ratification at the board's next regular meeting.
