Questions:

The following are questions submitted to the Maine Turnpike Authority in writing. Answers to the questions are noted. Bidders shall utilize this information in preparing their bid.

Question 1: Can you confirm the rail line beneath the St. Lawrence & Atlantic Overpass is a mainline track?

Response: *The track below the bridge is not a spur or siding track. Track maps and other available information regarding the track is available at <https://www.gwrr.com/slr/>.*

Question 2: Is the track beneath the St. Lawrence & Atlantic Overpass used for freight only?

Response: *There is no known regular passenger service on this line.*

Question 3: How many rail trips per day/week are there below the St. Lawrence & Atlantic Overpass?

Response: *The frequency of train traffic on this line is unknown. The Authority anticipates that the frequency of train traffic will not be more than 1-2 trains per day during construction. However, Contractor shall coordinate with the railroad to determine train frequency, schedule, and available work windows.*

Question 4: Will there be rail slowdown orders in effect during construction at the St. Lawrence & Atlantic Overpass? Speed?

Response: *The maximum authorized speed for trains and any speed restrictions at the bridge are unknown.*

Make the following changes to the bid documents:

In the Contract Documents, Special Provision Section 107.2 on pages SP-1 and 2, under the heading "Holidays" **ADD:**

Juneteenth No Restrictions

Independence Day 2025 (July Fourth) (6:00 a.m. preceding Tuesday to 6:00 a.m. the following Sunday)

Indigenous Peoples Day

12:01 p.m. preceding Friday to 6:00 a.m. the following Tuesday)

Note: The above items shall be considered as part of the bid submittal.
