Project Highlights

As part of this project, improvements to Route 112 (North St.) including the bridge over the turnpike will be done in 2025

- In total it is a \$42 million contract
- Repairs to the Route 112 Bridge will be approximately \$350,000
- This work is being done by Sargent Corp of Stillwater, ME
- Work is expected to start early this summer

The work consists of:

- Shoulders & sidewalks will be rebuilt
- New turn lanes will be installed
- Bridge deck pavement and membrane will be replaced
- Concrete repairs
- 2 new signalized intersections installed on Route 112

The new Exit 35 is anticipated to be complete in Fall 2025

The improvements to the Route 112 Bridge in Saco will impact local traffic on Route 112 and adjacent local roads this summer.

Day and night work is anticipated while the improvements are made. Travelers should be prepared for some delays during peak travel times.

This work will be done in multiple phases and will result in one lane of travel. All work is scheduled to be complete by the end of 2025.
