


Cumberland County population grew by 21% of its projected 2010-2040 level by 2016 Maine by 2.3%






Cumberland County employment grew by 21% of its projected 2010-2040 employment by 2015 Maine by 22.3%






Cumberland County's employment growth since the recession has left the region in better shape





Cumberland County accounted for 27% of job losses in the recession, but 45% of the recovery.

At the end of the recovery, Cumberland county's net job gain will be 350% higher than Maine








Four Scenarios: Population




How dense will Portland be?












Increasingly fuel efficient cars will result in a significant drop in fuel used even with expanded VKT
