Route 236 Bridge, Kittery



Project Highlights

- \$1.9 million project part of \$2.6 million contract
- Awarded to New England Infrastructure of Hudson, MA
- Bridge work includes deck repairs and pavement replacement
- Work also includes median repairs and approach work
- Work anticipated to begin on Monday, April 17, 2023
- One lane of traffic in each direction for 60 days (during spring and fall phases of project)
- From June 15 to Labor Day all four lanes will be open
- After Labor Day, one lane of traffic in each direction for duration of project

This project includes repairs to the Route 236 Bridge that crosses over the Maine Turnpike at Mile 1.25 in the Town of Kittery.

The work includes pavement and membrane replacement, deck expansion joint modifications, median repairs and approach work.

The bridge will remain open during construction, however the contractor will need to reduce traffic across the bridge to one lane to complete much of the work. Four lanes of traffic will be maintained from June 15 through Labor Day.

This work is tentatively scheduled to begin in the spring of 2023.
