

Andre Ouellette, of Sanford, was a pre-med student at the University of Maine and worked for the Maine Turnpike as a toll collector during the summers of 1971 and 1972. On July 12, 1972, Mr. Ouellette was fatally injured while exiting a toll booth at York Toll Plaza. He was struck by a vehicle operated by an intoxicated driver who drove through the toll lane without stopping. We honor Mr. Ouellette and his service to the Maine Turnpike Authority.
