

Wallace Danforth, of Litchfield, worked as a Turnpike highway maintenance employee in the 1970's. On November 5, 1973, Mr. Danforth was driving a maintenance vehicle along the turnpike in Lewiston and had slowed down in anticipation of road construction. A tractor trailer struck Mr. Danforth's vehicle from behind, and the impact of the accident sent the maintenance truck into the Ferry Road Bridge underpass abutment.
