OUESTIONS

1. Question: During the phased lane closures (behind barrier) for the bridge work, does the authority anticipated the cold planning and paving work to also be completed?

Answer: The interim completion dates and incentives/disincentives are ties to when long term lane closures and barrier are allowed to be in place to complete the bridge joint work. Milling and paving do not need to be completed within this time frame and can be completed with short term lane closures within the times noted in the 652 Lane Closure Tables and temperature restrictions of the associated work. However, traffic will not be allowed to operate directly on the membrane. Any membrane patch repairs that are not completed behind barrier must be completed and covered with at least temporary pavement prior to allowing traffic. Any temporary pavement that is necessary for the joint repair work due temperature restrictions shall be incidental to the joint repair item.
